CARE OF AMMUNITION CHEST

1st. Keep everything out that does not belong in them, except a batch of cord or wire for breakage; beware of loose tacks, nails, bolts, or straps.
 2nd. Keep friction primers in their papers, tied up. The pack containing those for instant service must be closed, and so placed as to be secure.
 Take every precaution that primers do not get loose: a single one may cause an explosion. Use plenty of tow in packing.
